## INTRODUCTION

# Living in the Matrix

For me, the world is like a dream of the mind, in a constant state of change, and can therefore, never ultimately be relied upon to hold all of our answers. Science proves this, identifying the world as lacking real substance and made up entirely of energy, a holographic matrix. Even in a dream, though, there are many pathways, maps and guides to help you find your way. Some of these may lead you astray, some prove reliable, but none is more right or wrong than any other in a dream. Life is an individual experience, and what is necessary or helpful to one person, may not be for another. Numerology is the same. There are many number systems, and all have value and purpose. I believe these numerology systems are one form of life's maps or guides, to help you create better circumstances for yourself. Because your perception can change your reality, this world would have to be in a constant state of change, which eventually leads to

chaos, or as I call it, *The Law of Chaos*. God (or the Creator/Central Source if you prefer), is the only true constant. God's *Law of Grace* is what raises us up out of our illusions into happier outcomes; into joy and peace. Numerology helps get us a step closer to accepting this Grace, and avoiding the suffering of the world. It is the ego's belief that we need to suffer and sacrifice. When we decide to look at our numbers, we are seeking a higher path of joy; a joy which is the equivalent to the Godly State of Being, and a softening of the painful experiences.

There is more than one thought system on how Chaldean Numerology should be calculated. I have taken the basic Chaldean number system and their age-old meanings a few steps further, backing up my findings with patterns of conclusive repetitions, based on studying the lives of others. There are many other forms of numerology being practiced today that have different methods for calculating, because they are used for different purposes.

Chaldean Numerology has not been something one could find on mainstream bookshelves, as there have been very few books written about this number system. There are plenty of numerology books available, but for years, the large majority of these were based on a western interpretation of Pythagorean Numerology. This is a totally different system, and I want to stress here that these two systems of numbers, Pythagorean and Chaldean have different purposes, and therefore should not be mixed together. I see a lot of people taking what little information is available on Chaldean numbers, and substituting the Pythagorean rules to compensate or fill in the empty blanks. This does not work, as you would be creating a whole new number system that would need to be tested on its own. A good example of this,

is someone adding their whole birth date together to get the Pythagorean “Life Path Number”, and reading the Chaldean meanings for that number. For one thing, this particular form of Chaldean Numerology does not add the entire birth date together to arrive at one of the personal numbers. If you have a “Life Path Number of 9” in Pythagorean, it means that you are a humanitarian type of person and this is your style of relating, as well as your motivation in life. “Nine” in Chaldean, however, means someone who is prone to having a temper, and would be dealing with war-like situations. The Chaldean nine is based on the day of birth, and connected to the qualities of the planet Mars.

Another good example of someone attempting to merge these two systems is carrying over Master Numbers (11, 22, 33, 44) from Pythagorean to Chaldean. Some have been using the Pythagorean rule that a master number should not be reduced when calculating in Chaldean. There are no master numbers in this form of Chaldean, and not reducing them in certain calculations causes you to come up with a number outcome that is misleading or incorrect. Master Numbers relate to a person’s character development in Pythagorean, whereas the 11, 22, 33 and 44 are reduced in Chaldean calculations as needed, to find the predictive fate of the person. (I am not disagreeing with anyone who includes “master numbers” in studying *other* forms of Chaldean, or new versions of numerology that they themselves have tested.)

There are many “Chaldean Numerology” sites on the internet today, that are missing the key elements in their calculations that make this system work. For example, one cannot say, “I changed your name to a “23”, which is a *very fortunate* number, and your life is going to be wonderful now.” There is more to the story for it to create enough of a change

to actually turn the person's life around. (One has to look at how all the numbers interact with one another.) In some cases, the individual's life gets worse. I know. I have experimented on myself many times with name changes. Add to that, the Hidden Number is all but ignored in these numerology calculations, as are the individual rules for each number. Therefore, I will endeavor to address and simplify these missed steps, so that it may advantage the many seeking assistance and a bettering of their life from this number system.

### **The differences:**

As can be seen, these are two completely different systems. There are also a lot of differences in Hindu, Gematria, "phonetic" Chaldean etc.

### ***Who are the Chaldeans?***

There are many theories about this mysterious group of people, and differing versions of their history and teachings.

Some has been preserved by modern-day Brahmins. The Chaldeans lived for a time in an area southeast of Babylonia towards the coast of the Persian Gulf, on the right bank of the Euphrates. They arrived around 1000 BC. In Assyrian, the name was “Kaldu”. The Chaldeans were not native to Mesopotamia, but migrated from India. They were not Arameans, but Brahmanical Hindus (now called Aryans). When they ruled all of southern Mesopotamia for a short time, “Babylonia” became synonymous, (mostly with the Greeks and Jews), with “Chaldean,” but the Chaldeans were not Babylonians. The Chaldeans spoke a West Semitic language, but eventually adopted the Babylonian dialect of Akkadian, which was for the most part the same, with the exception of slight differences in phonetics and characters. <sup>1</sup> These ancient peoples were known as astrologers or star worshipers, and were far ahead of modern times in their mathematical calculations and grasp of astronomy, astrology, philosophy, architecture, numerology, divining and magic. The Chaldeans believed in one deity, but revered the Sun, Moon and other celestial bodies as symbols of that deity. The Egyptians, Hebrews, Assyrians and Greeks learned the Chaldean sciences.

Supposedly Sabeism was the religion of the ancient Chaldeans, but its principles are misinterpreted, and cannot be grasped or studied, as they are lost. The Chaldean Book of Numbers or “Book of Dzyan” and other writings are in Arabic, their knowledge guarded by specific Sufi initiates. <sup>2</sup> It is believed that Chaldeans recognized and denounced the dark side, or what would be known as “fallen angels”. Or this is what we surmise from ancient Jewish mysticism and the

knowledge of the use of amulets and symbols being worn to ward off demons. The Chaldeans honored a Sabbath day of rest, as well as other days reserved for prayer and gratitude. The number seven was considered sacred.

Chaldeans seem to be connected to alchemy as well, being considered the oldest known “magicians”. They believed that true power of magic came from the power of the soul, and the knowledge of the alchemical or magical properties of plants, minerals and animals. They were able to contact higher spiritual beings using the psychic senses, religious rites and prayer. To the Chaldeans, control of the physical world was merely scientific, accomplished by observing the natural laws. This knowledge made their feats appear as “miracles” or magic to others. These were ancient scientists, and they were brilliant. The wisdom and practice of ancient scientists had one natural philosophy in common that they followed, and that was to observe with their senses. They based facts that made sense on every level of the universe, not just the physical.

The following is becoming common knowledge, but I find it interesting that in the Hebrew Bible, Abraham, the founding father of the Jewish religion came from “Ur of the Chaldeans”. (In Bactria there was a Jewish nation named Jaguda, or Ur-Jaguda. Ur meant “place or town”.) It is also interesting that other philosophic writers of Jewish history agree and name Abraham as a teacher of science and astrology:

- Tomas Doreste, who in his book “Moises y los Extraterrestres”, writes that the philosopher Voltaire believed Abraham to be descended from Brahman priests who had left India, and shared their teachings throughout

Persia, to the lands near the Tigris and Euphrates. Voltaire noted that the city of Ur was near the border of Persia, the road to India where Brahma had been born. (Midway on this road is Bactria, a mountainous area where Brahma was said to be from.) “Chaldean” or “Kaul-Deva” (Holy Kauls) was the title of an ancient Hindu priestly caste of Brahmins.

- Philo of Alexandria, a Hellenistic Jewish philosopher from ancient Egypt, in the time of the Roman Empire had this to say in his doctrine *On Abraham*, “The Chaldeans exercised themselves most especially with astronomy, and attributed all things to the movement of the stars, believing that whatever is in the world is governed by forces encompassed in numbers and numerical proportions...seeking out the numerical arrangement according to the cycles of the Sun and Moon, the planets, and the fixed stars...”
- An ancient Jewish writer Eupolemus, (150 B.C.) writes that Abraham was trained in astrology, emigrated from Chaldea to Phoenicia and taught the Phoenicians. Abraham also lived with, and taught the Egyptian priests at Heliopolis, and is descended from the “race of giants”. According to Eupolemus, Abraham is glorified as the father of all science.
- The Jewish historian Artapanus of Alexandria, an Egyptian, wrote “Concerning the Jews,” (250 - 100 BC). In this historical work, which was written in Greek, the three Jewish patriarchs Abraham, Joseph and Moses were responsible for altering the culture of the Near East. Abraham in particular taught the Egyptian Pharaoh Pharaohthes the science of astrology.

- Flavius Josephus, a Jewish scholar and historian mentions in his book “The Antiquities of the Jews” that Abraham taught science to the Egyptians, who in turn taught the Greeks.

## Why Does Numerology Work?

Believing in numerology is an act of faith. Science can prove how numbers measure, but cannot prove why numbers seem to affect us. The belief in the efficacy of numerology is in the seeing of patterns over and over. It is in the experience of using it, that belief and confidence in the system is found. Science can prove a lot of things, such as gravity. If a tree branch breaks off, it will hit the ground. Science, however, cannot tell you if the tree branch that hangs over the room you currently sit in, is going to break and come through the roof. It is an act of faith that you sit there. It is an act of faith, every time you make plans for tomorrow, and go to bed. Science cannot tell you if you are going to die in your sleep, and there will be no tomorrow. Therefore, science has its place, as do the things that are outside its parameters. Life, then, is an act of faith. So, you may never be able to fully understand why numerology works, but following its patterns and your experiences with it, will show that it does. Numerology reminds me of psychology. The latter is considered a science, but it is really just a noticing of patterns of behavior. It is not a proven factual system. Numerology, like psychology is the study of how numbers affect our behavior and future experiences, only “proven” by observation and reaffirmation of its reliable consistency. If you approached the idea that numbers have an effect on your life, from a

scientific viewpoint, you would say that everything is made up of numbers in its very nature, form, organization and structure. Therefore, numbers rule your world. You cannot set your alarm, buy a car, pay a bill, watch TV, call a friend or any “number” of other things without numbers. Your world is measured and run by magical digits.

The ancient Chaldeans discovered an agreement between the seasons and certain fixed stars. Thus began their belief that the Earth and heaven were interrelated, and ran in cycles. They studied and documented the numerical patterns of the stars and planets, and noted their effects on our lives. These cosmic bodies magnetically affect you, just as the moon’s tides, solar flares and sunspots cause changes in the earth’s atmosphere and weather. (Or is it us, affecting them?)

Numbers in numerology relate to the energy of your name and birth date. Your personal numbers are connected to the planets in our solar system, including the Sun and Moon. We know that energy matter is made up of atoms, which contain electrons or protons. These electrons and protons have magnetic charges of positive or negative, just like a battery. Your human cells are magnets. You have an electrical body and brain waves, measured in terms of electromagnetic energy frequencies. Your emotions are electromagnetic energy, and are vibrating at a certain magnetic frequency level. This is why your thoughts or moods can repel or attract another person. Others can feel or sense the mood or emotions you are projecting. Because you are a magnet, the magnetic charge of the Sun's solar flares would naturally, then, affect you, as well as the Earth. Everything is magnetics, and everything happens in a numerological order that can be mapped and logged with numbers. So,

Numerology is a study of these planetary number energies, and their affect on human life.

There is a new cosmology on “plasma”, which is considered a newly discovered element (solid, liquid, gas, plasma). It is believed to make up 99.99% of the entire universe, visible and invisible. Plasma in space is a mixture of hot charged particles - ions and electrons, generating a lot of energy. It is only when it is cooled down that plasma becomes a solid, liquid or gas we would see on Earth. We have learned to function with and utilize these lower states of slowed down magnetic particles. In space, plasmas remain electrically charged and respond more to electromagnetic forces than to gravity. “Empty space” is alive with a constant flow of plasma. Large bodies in space are believed to be interacting through magnetics, which is much stronger than gravity. In other words, planetary bodies appear to be “moving” based on whether they are attracting or repelling. Anyone can see this dominance of magnetics over gravity by using simple magnets. Plasma waves are traveling at an unlimited velocity, not as transverse waves of light. They are longitudinal waves, and therefore not limited to the speed of light. Plasma needs an electric current to run on. <sup>3</sup>

Think about the fact that your thoughts are electrically charged protein molecules. Your blood flow is an electrical current system. Every cell in your body is a pulsating electrical entity. All of it regulated, and measurable by numbers. I will leave it here for you to think deeper on the planetary magnetic connections to you, their connections to number patterns, and their ultimate influence on your life. It

is through study and experience that one begins to believe that the effects are measurable and real. Remember Morphic Resonance?<sup>4</sup> Everything is by habit, thus creating pattern, and thus measurable by numbers...and changeable...

## *Changing My Name*

As I said before, I felt my life was cursed. We all have our difficulties. I was stuck for years in a pattern of attracting emotionally abusive relationships with men. They were addicted to either alcohol or drugs, and were financial vampires. Because of this, I struggled with money almost my whole adult life, and became a workaholic by necessity, with little or no vacations. Add to that, my health was a constant challenge, forcing me to give up many pleasure foods, follow strict dietary habits and find alternative ways to heal myself. Also, strange circumstances frequently seemed to happen to me, to single me out. I remember in my high school yearbook, my picture was the only one without my name next to it. Senior year, my name was not on the voting list for prom court. Although enough people had penciled me in to qualify me being on the court, student council suggested a re-vote. I thought it would be too embarrassing, so I declined. As I grew older, and continued to be singled out in many strange ways, I began to feel as if I something was wrong with me, and imagined that maybe I did not actually exist!

In an effort to change my patterns and circumstances, I

turned to Chaldean Numerology. Because I had what I considered unlucky numbers, I started experimenting with changing my name. I used completely different names, and versions of my own name, altering the spelling. I found that my luck did not improve, but rather got worse. I eventually noticed patterns, and realized there were specific rules that had to be followed. One of the versions of my name was a “twelve”, the number of sacrifice. Years of feeling the effects of the “sacrifice”, led me to eventually come to a crisis point and realization. The twelve magnetically led me to move to a town, which added to the number “12”, hence doubling its effect. Then everything became twelve. Membership numbers added to twelve, my address number, the apartment number, the time displayed on the clock, my change due at the store, credit card numbers, pet names...all twelves. The number continued to follow me. Anything I tried to accomplish in this town was jinxed or wrecked, including an engagement to a fiancé. It was time to sacrifice this name, or become the sacrifice.

In late fall of 2013, I decided to again change the name I was using, determined that it be the last time. I wanted to keep some semblance of my birth name, but this proved to be more difficult than I had anticipated. (Sometimes no version of a person’s birth name will work.) I settled on “Anmarie Uber”, the only spelling that would harmonize with my birth number, and create luckier numbers. (Privately, I still use the previous version, *and the influence of both is felt in my life.*) The results have been astonishing. Even though the old spelling continues to curse me, “Anmarie Uber” has brought in many new blessings.

I used the new name for the first time, as an instructor of a workshop. That day I met my Twin Flame. He took the class, and we found that we had a very special spiritual

connection. I attributed our meeting to my name change. My career life shifted quickly and radically, as well, with opportunities to teach even more classes, and write this book. Media coverage showed up out of nowhere. People were finding me, and I was suddenly no longer invisible to my good fortune. It was as if many obstacles had been removed from my path. In a month's time, of changing my name, I began regularly blogging, my online audience tripled, and I got offered to speak on two radio shows. My classes were getting booked out. So, I want to say here that I don't agree with those who believe it takes a long time to see changes after altering one's name. If it is done correctly, these will be positive changes.

This book will teach you how Chaldean Numerology is connected with Astrology. Each root number is assigned to a planet in our solar system, and has a magnetic affect on our future. You will benefit from my years spent testing the rules, looking for patterns, teaching this course, and evolving the system into a simplified model that anyone can understand and utilize to improve their life. You, too, can learn how to use Chaldean Numerology to show you what fate has in store for you, and what you can do about changing that fate. I leave you now, to discover your destiny numbers...



## CHAPTER ONE

# 5 Numbers that Determine Destiny

How much did you pay for this book? How many pages are in it? You need numbers to answer these questions. Everything in our world, our bodies, nature and the entire cosmos is made up of mathematical equations of numbers, utilizing the root numbers 1- 9. We do not know the origin of numbers, yet numbers tell us what day it is, where we live, what time we need to be at work, how many bones are in our body, and the measure of the gravitation, mass and speed of light that determines the size of a black hole in outer space! All of life can, amazingly enough, be measured with combinations of *just nine numbers*.

These nine root numbers recur in a sequence that repeats itself, with the use of the zero determining the next series of numbers:

1 - 9

10 (1+0) =1

11 (1+1) =2

12 (1+2) =3

13 (1+3) = 4 ; and so on.

*It is amazing to think that combinations of just nine root numbers and zero, will allow us to count up to infinity and beyond.*

## Your 5 Destiny Numbers

There are five numbers in particular that can open or close doors, attract lucky or unlucky circumstances, and create or remove obstacles to your success and happiness. These are derived from your birth date and name. They are simple to calculate, and act as a snapshot or blueprint of your life, setting the stage for what type of luck you are likely to experience along the way. I call these five your Destiny Numbers. Destiny Numbers represent the outer workings of fate acting on your life. They are indicators of major events at some point in the future, and determine the amount of success an individual experiences. In some cases the Destiny Numbers reveal the manner in which you may die. I think everyone's life, in some area, feels a little out of control. Sometimes all of it seems out of control. The good news is, it is simple to alter unlucky destiny numbers to a more positive vibration.

You can empower your life by getting familiar with these five numbers, creating a flow that will eventually overcome or reduce obstacles, heartache and lack... none of which are your birthright. The Destiny Numbers are as follows:

### ● THE DAY NUMBER

The first Destiny Number is derived from the day you were born. It may be a single or compound (double) number. It is called the “Day Number”.

An example: If you were born on Dec. 2, your Day Number is “2”, a single digit. If you were born on Dec. 20<sup>th</sup>, your Day Number is “20”, a “compound” or “double” number (but it also breaks down to a “2”, because  $(2+0=2)$ ). The number “2” and the number “20” are both “2s”, but will each have their own meanings. Both will have a strong influence on your life.

*The Day Number is one of the most important numbers, because it cannot be altered, and therefore must harmonize with the other numbers. An individual cannot change the day on which they were born, so in essence they came into this life with the Day Number, and have to play out its influence. For this reason, it is said to reflect karma accumulated from past lives. This could represent beneficial rewards, or unresolved negative lessons. The Day Number will give you certain personality tendencies or propensities toward certain experiences. It is how others see you, what type of material is attracted to you, or what can happen to you in life. I will discuss your Day Number in more depth in the next chapter.*

### ● THE INDIVIDUAL NAME NUMBER(S) (INN)

Each letter of the alphabet has a numeric value assigned

to it, and the INNs are found by separately adding together the letters in your first name, last name, and/or any other names used in how you are addressed, such as middle name, an initial or titles, such as “Reverend.” An INN is the sum total of each name, and it is more common to have at least two or more, as most people use a first and last name. Each name number total, by itself, has an influence on your life. If one is commonly known by only a single INN, such as “Cher”, “Shakira”, or “Madonna”, then there would only be one Individual Name Number (INN).

The name used for calculating your “Individual Name Number(s)” (INN), is the name you use the most, or how you are most commonly addressed by others. This includes nicknames. If you are almost always known by, and use a first and last name, you will calculate two INNs. If you are always called by a first, middle *and* last name, you will calculate three INNs.

*This number is important, because it is the only one you can change, in turn, altering the vibration of the other numbers.*

## ● THE TOTAL NAME NUMBER (TNN)

The “Total Name Number” (TNN) is the sum total of all the Individual Name Numbers (INNs). You add the first name INN total to the last name INN total, to find the TNN. (Note: The INN and TNN are not set in stone, and can be altered by the changing of one’s name. This would be an option if one had unfortunate numbers and wanted to change their influence. There are specific rules for this that must be followed, and will be addressed later in this book.) *It is very important that the TNN be in harmony with the Day Number* (see “Natural Harmonies” in this chapter). In Chapter Three, you

will learn more about calculating your name numbers.

### ● THE HIDDEN NUMBER

The “Hidden Number” is found by adding the Total Name Number (TNN) to the Day Number. Like the other destiny numbers, the Hidden Number represents a fate that will befall a person, but it is a hidden fate that we are unaware of, until we add the Day and TNN together. The Hidden Number is often ignored when choosing a different name, or calculating numbers, and can lead to unfortunate circumstances in one’s future. There are specific rules to follow with this as well, and these will be addressed in Chapter Four.

### ● THE PERIOD NUMBER

The “Period Number” is based on a certain time period in which you were born. It relates to astrology Sun signs. If you were born in late April or the first three quarters of May, you are a “Taurus”. This time period of Taurus has the number “6” assigned to it. Therefore, if you are a Taurus your “Period Number” is 6. Like the Day Number, *the Period Number cannot be altered*, but it can help enhance the positive qualities of your other numbers, and be used to harmonize otherwise negative numbers. (More on Period Numbers in Chapter Five.)
